ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

EDITORIAL GUIDELINES TO AUTHOR

- Only abstracts which address research conducted in the field of haematological disorders is acceptable.
 - The abstract title must be in title case, followed by the names of the authors and their institutional affiliations. Underline the name of the presenting author. The font size should be 12, Arial or similar.
 - The body of the abstract should include the following headings: Introduction, Methods and Patients, Results and Conclusions.
 - The body of the abstract should have up to 2500 characters (spaces included). All typing must be in single space and the text should be a single paragraph.
 - The abstract should be self-explanatory, have all the relevant information and not include vague terminology (such as "...results will be presented...")
 - Papers may be laboratory topics, description of clinical studies or case reports. An interesting case report may be chosen as a topic in the "Clinical Debates" section.
 - The abstract should be sent in electronic form to the symposium secretary Coleen Fredericks, e-mail: coleen.fredericks@uct.ac.za by **Tuesday 3 May 2016.**
