

## **RESEARCH OFFICER / SENIOR RESEARCH OFFICER: Perinatal Mental Health Project**

The Perinatal Mental Health Project (PMHP) requires the services of a Research Officer/Senior Research Officer (SRO). This is a full time post for a **one-year contract** with appointment starting as soon as possible. The appointee will be based at the PMHP offices on UCT's Sawkins Road campus, but may need to travel locally and nationally.

## **Requirements:**

- Masters degree in Public Health or Psychology (or similar training and skills set).
- Track record of publications in peer-reviewed journals
- Thorough working knowledge of statistical packages for data analysis
- Ability to conduct and analyse qualitative and quantitative research
- Advanced organizational, prioritization and time-management skills
- Excellent writing skills including academic and report writing
- Ability to prioritize large volumes of work, and to meet deadlines efficiently
- Ability to coordinate and manage the day-to-day operations of the research and data collection activities of multiple sites
- Knowledge of principles of research design, ethical and regulatory requirements of research involving human subjects
- Ability to maintain records of research activities, and prepare periodic and ad hoc reports, as required by investigator, administrator, funding agencies, and/or regulatory bodies
- Ability to organize various study meetings, site monitoring visits, other research related meetings and events
- Highly proficient computer skills, including word processing, preparation of spreadsheet and presentations, and navigation of the online programs or databases available on the Internet
- Ability to work well as member of a team as well as independently
- Valid driving license and own car

Willingness to travel to sites around Cape Town and other parts of South Africa

- Additional qualification required for Senior Research Officer:
  - PhD in relevant discipline (e.g. Public Health, Psychology, Development studies etc.)
  - Evidence of procuring research grant awards
  - Experience in liaising with international researchers and programmes
  - Experience of research project management at senior level
  - Experience in supervision of post-graduate students
  - Interest in women's mental health

- Contribute to other research projects with which the PMHP partners
- Pursue research grants for the PMHP
