We are looking for original films that innovatively share knowledge on the four Symposium themes:

- 1. People-centred health systems and how to strengthen systems to promote greater responsiveness, better health, human rights and social justice;
- 2. Innovative research approaches and measures for generating systematic and rigorous knowledge of, and engaging people in action towards, people-centred health systems;
- 3. Novel strategies for developing the capacities needed to conduct people-centred health policy and systems research, covering formal teaching programmes and broader capacity-development initiatives;
- 4. Original experience of learning communities and knowledge translation platforms engaged in strengthening health systems.

We will select films based on content, cinematography and ability to convey the message in a way that supports the theme of health systems strengthening and people-centred health care.

Although it is not a requirement, film-makers are welcome to attend the Symposium film session at their own cost should their film be selected.

Successful films will be announced in July 2014.
