Week 3	•	Conducting effective classroom tutorials
	•	Dealing with diversity and differences
Week 4	•	Assessment of students
	•	Giving feedback

The sessions will be in the format of group discussions. Participants will be expected to read one or two carefully selected and relevant articles before each session, and to reflect on their own experiences as students and as teachers in the light of the reading material. They will be encouraged to share their insights with the group. Finally they will consider how they might improve their own teaching.

The programme seeks to affirm current good practice, identify gaps in educational knowledge, and provide insight into new educational methods. In this way it aims to inspire clinical educators and heighten their enthusiasm for good teaching.
