Course requirements:

Course work: (60% of grade)

- Test at the end of each of 4 themes, as per course schedule
- Participation in lecturer-led journal clubs (in red on the schedule)
- Presentation of your own research (as per course schedule). Students will be required to answer questions posed during the presentation and those that will be posed by instructors in advance of the presentation
- 30-40 minute journal club presentation of a critical assessment of a published scientific report approved by the instructor

<u>Final examination: (40% of grade)</u> tentatively scheduled for 5th September, based upon an estimate of 12 students. The exact date will depend upon enrolment and how many sessions are needed for oral presentations. The date of the final exam will be finalised during the month of May.

<u>Lecture attendance:</u> Students will be required to attend at least 75% of the lectures (including the first lecture, unless the course convener is contacted in advance) and 75% of the student oral presentations in order to pass the course's DP (duly performed) requirements.
