Register for our Masithethe isiXhosa course. This is a FREE short course offered by the Multilingualism Education Project based in the Centre for Higher Education Development (CHED). After completion of the course you will be able to engage in isiXhosa basic conversation acts such as greetings, personal introductions, description of work situations, giving information about family, and making of simple requests. You will also acquire basic knowledge of African culture, Xhosa culture in particular.

The course will be offered from March to May and August to October The course comprises of 12 sessions (you may attend one or two lectures per week during meridian or in the evenings in student residences). **Class size will be limited to not more than 15 participants.** A certificate of completion of the course will be awarded to participants who take a short oral assessment at the end of the course. For those who do not wish to take assessment, a certificate of attendance (requiring participation in at least 10 of the 12 sessions) will be awarded.

The course is FREE to UCT staff and registered students.
