

- Proper training about working with pesticide.
- Knowing about the pesticides you work with and how to notice symptoms of poisoning.
- Workers should be able to insist their co-workers work safely.
- Adequate sources of water for washing in case of a spill.
- Separate lockers for dirty and clean overalls.

- Correct personal protective equipment.
- Being warned if pesticide is being sprayed near my home or where I am working.
- Regular health check-ups when working with very dangerous pesticides.

• A facility to wash overalls at the workplace, so that poison soaked overalls are not taken home.
