

Activate the wi-fi connection (from the settings menu) on your device. Type in your:

1. Username: Studentnumber@wf.uct.ac.za
2. Password: UCT network password

All UCT formal communication and Vula notifications (by default) are sent to your MyUCT account. Keep up-to-date with MyUCT email while off-campus, by setting up your mobile device.

How to set up your mobile device to connect to Office

365: Access via IMAP, ActiveSync

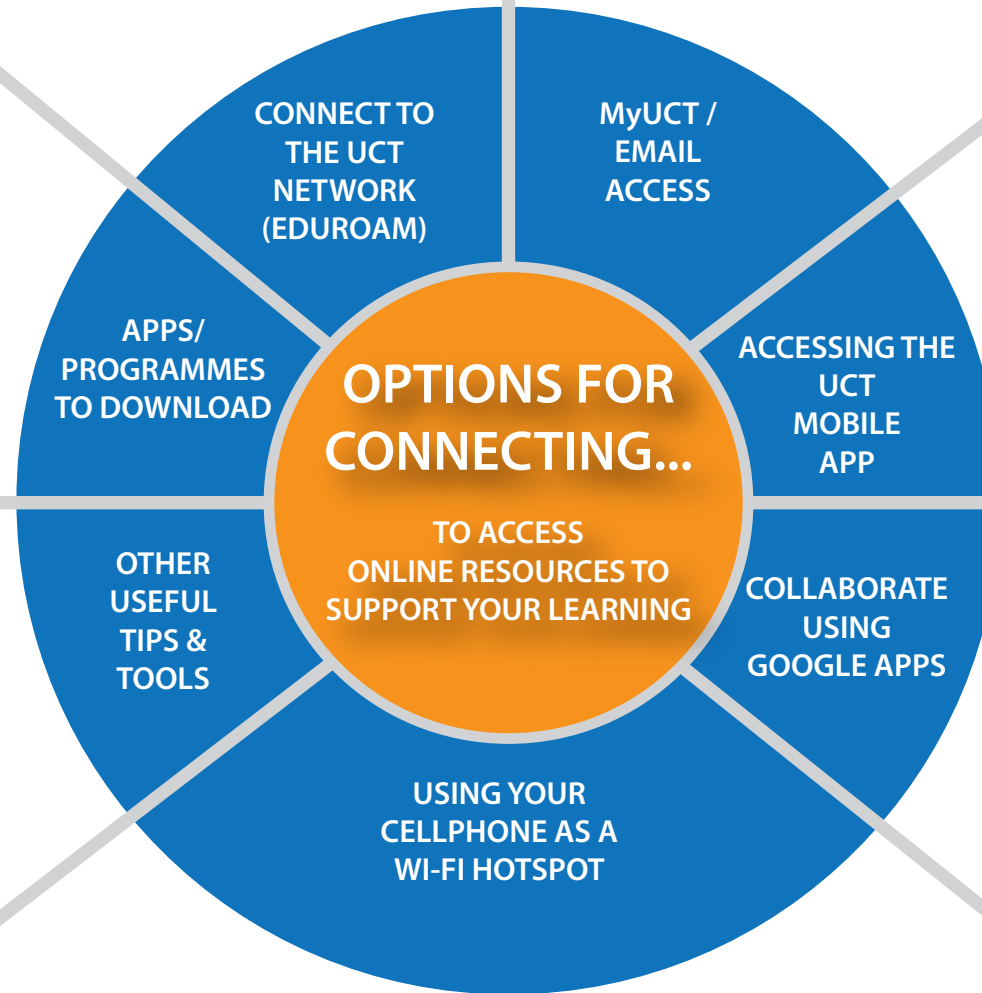

How to download UCT Mobile onto your mobile device:
Go to: iTunes App store, Google Play store or Blackberry World > Search: UCT Mobile > Download
For support, e-mail: uctmobile@uct.ac.za

Applications or programmes you may need to download onto your mobile device include:
(Most of these can be downloaded from the Google Play Store)

1. Adobe Acrobat reader: For reading, annotating – highlighting and creating notes on your PDF document
2. Media player: for playing videos

To save on data, download frequently used files, journal articles (from the library), etc. onto your device or flash drive where possible.

Click Off-campus access

Enter your student number and password

After you have clicked on the Vula icon, click My Sites. Below your sites list, click the button "Switch to Full view"

If you want to collaborate with peers while off-campus, you can use your Gmail account or myUCT email address to access Google applications
