ASSA Media Report

<u>Overview</u>

This report is a record of the 282 electronic articles in South African media that contain the string of letters 'actuar', for the period of 1 July to 30 September 2020. Please contact Pieter du Toit (pddutoit@gmail.com) or Billy Enderstein (billy.enderstein@gmail.com) to get access to the full database of articles.

168 of these articles appear in media sources that do not receive very high circulation (e.g. local newspapers, blogs and special interest web pages). These articles are only discussed in the very last section of this report.

The intended audience of the report includes members and employees of the Actuarial Society of South Africa and participants of Mind Matters.

1. Summary of electronic articles in widely circulated mainstream news media

1.1. Discovery Health celebrates women in leadership

The Actuarial Society of South Africa was explicitly mentioned in 17 articles in this quarter whereas the second quarter mentioned ASSA in 36 articles.




Figure 1: Breakdown of 114 articles based on different news media source
